

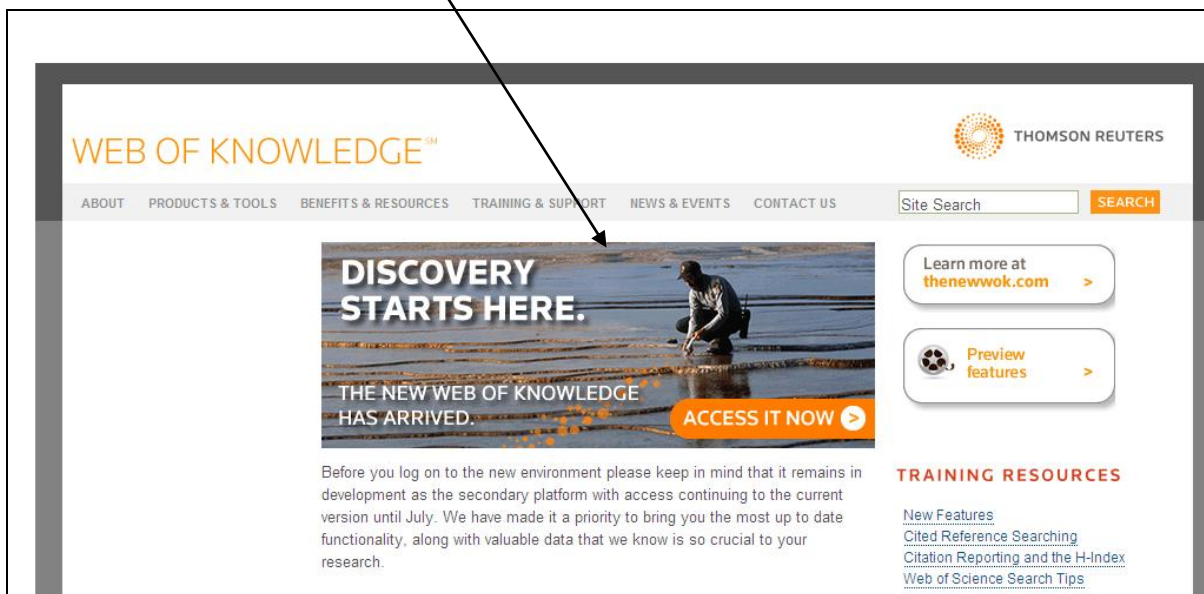
## Web of Knowledge Version 5
